# Mentoring for Women Producers

The EWA Network's Producers' Mentoring Scheme is a 10-month career enhancement programme for 16 female independent audiovisual producers. Launched in 2018, the Scheme enables participants to upgrade their core professional skills and competencies such as financing, negotiating, management and business development. It is aimed at female producers established in Europe, with at least five years of proven experience in audiovisual production, who are ready to acquire new skills and advance their careers.

The Mentoring Scheme is an exclusive programme specifically aimed at women producers who have already made their mark at a national level and who now wish to take the next step to a wider European/international dimension.

# What is Mentoring?

Business mentoring is a one-to-one relationship focused on the mentee's need to develop/reinforce specific competences, skills, and a problem-solving attitude, as well as on the availability and capability of the mentor to provide advice on those issues. The experience and competences of the mentor match the specific needs of the mentee.

Mentoring is not training. Training schemes have general objectives, well-structured activities and group dynamics. Mentoring is a tailor-made activity based on the specific relationship between mentor and mentee. It is a space where the mentee can ask questions that would be difficult to raise in a training group.

**EWA Network's Producers' Mentoring Scheme** would allow mentees to upgrade the core skills and competences needed in their profession such as financing, negotiating, management and business development. Mentors do not deliver solutions to mentees, the purpose of mentoring is not to achieve results in a specific project/activity, but to support the mentee's professional growth and to take the next career step in a direction they themselves identify during the mentoring process.

# Why Mentoring?

Mentoring has revealed itself to be one of the strongest tools to help women to grow within closed business environments. Women do not need "more" training, on average they are already well trained, and often better trained than male producers, but in industries where networking and personal links are very strong, mentoring is a clear tool to enhance women's social capital and improve their business skills to have better access to the market. That is why EWA Network launched its first mentoring programme in 2018.

We are proud to have launched the 4th edition in 2022 with the partnership of Thessaloniki's Co-production Market and When East Meets West Co-production market in Trieste and the support of Creative Europe.



Their mission is to search for new cinematic language and forms, and to promote Russian independent cinema in the global film industry.

KINOKULT focus on domestic production and international coproduction of documentary and feature films with potential for international distribution. Our filmography includes films that have received awards at both Russian and international film festivals (in Europe, Asia and the U.S.). They have presented projects in various stages of development at co-production markets such as Karlovy Vary IFF's Works in Progress, Les Arcs Industry Village, Producers Network (Marche du Film), and Roskino's Key Buyers Event.



The film got a limited release run of screenings at movie theaters. Thus, this film made her one of the youngest producers of feature films in Norway. In 2016, her graduation film from the National Film School of Norway *Generation Mars* got nominated to the 43th Academy Student Award. The



film became a finalist for the **60th CINE Golden Eagle Award** and also represented Norway as nominee for the **CILECT Price**.

After graduating from film school in 2016, Elisa started fulltime at Mer Film as a producer together with producer Maria Ekerhovd. Mer Film was founded in 2011 and develop, produce and distribute Norwegian and international arthouse films. Mer Film focus on diversity, innovation and social relevance. Elisa is in charge of non- European co-productions, head of television, Mer Film talent development program and leads the North Norwegian office.

**Snežana** also produced 39 episodes of the TV show *Morning Changes Everything* (2018) that aired on RTS as well as a period TV show *Bad Blood* (2021) that was broadcasted on National Broadcaster RTS.

Currently, she has one TV show and three films in different stages of development and financing, while a film *Mother Mara*, the second feature film of **Mirjana Karanovic** as a director, a co-production with six countries, received support from **Eurimages** is currently in early editing stage.

**Snežana** participated in **Producers on The Move** in **Cannes** in 2015. She has been teaching Film Production at **FMK**, the Faculty of Media and Communications in Belgrade. She is a voting member of **European Film Academy** since 2016.


